

FREE MEDICAL CAMP AT KASUMBA NURSERY AND PRIMARY SCHOOL

As part of celebrating our 10 years anniversary, a free medical camp was hosted at Kasumba Nursery and Primary School, Mubende Town, on Saturday, 9th July 2016. This was part of our Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) and our appreciation to the people in the community for the support they had provided to the school in those 10 years. The camp was facilitated by 38 health practitioners that were led by Dr. Josephine Ssewanyana. People came from near and as far as 20 kms. There were babies, children, adults and elderly in their 80s. The services that were provided benefited many people as indicated below:
